## **Michigan Chamber on Michigan Public Service Commission order on Line 5, Great Lakes Tunnel**

The Michigan Chamber of Commerce today released the following statement from Jim Holcomb, president & CEO, after the Michigan Public Service Commission's action on U-20763 - the application for the authority to replace and relocate the segment of Line 5 crossing the Straits of Mackinac into a tunnel beneath the Straits:
