Endorsements are made by the organization's PAC Board, comprised of member employers from across the state representing diverse industries and businesses of all sizes.

Candidates are evaluated based on their records and positions on issues affecting Michigan employers and the state's competitiveness. The process includes a combination of voting records (for incumbents), candidate questionnaires and personal interviews.
